A New Opportunity to get Involved!

We are starting a new fund raising activity for our council. It's called the 911 Address Sign Project. Some of you may recall last year when Ted Mattis invited Brad Saxton from council 11664 to come and talk to us about this project that there council had been doing for some years. They have been very successful with it in Leelanau County, and we are going to give it a try in Grand Traverse County too.

We need some Knights to step up and get involved! This is a chance for any of you who are not currently active for whatever reason to get involved at the beginning of a new activity that will hopefully bring many years of successful fund raising to our council.

The basic idea is a “911 Address Sign”. This sign is placed near the road, out in front of a home or business to display the street number. This helps emergency responders and others easily and quickly find your house.

These signs would be available for people to acquire thru a suggested donation to the Knights.

The signs will be offered as a do-it-yourself kit, or, for an additional donation we will install them. The sign itself can be installed onto an existing pole or purchased with a pole for installation.

All proceeds from the donations for these signs will go into the council’s general fund.

If you’re interested in helping out with any aspect of this project, please contact me at 231-645-2748. We need help with the administration stuff as well as volunteers to install the signs around their local neighborhood.

I’m also sending out an order form with this newsletter. We are trying to pre-sell as many of the signs as we can to help with the initial funding. So if you can afford to, please buy one for yourself, and help us get the ball rolling!
